The people who sign this Safeguarding Charter agree to promote and uphold the rights and freedoms of all our customers and those who use our services. We commit to -

- 1 Promote equality and inclusion in our culture and treat all people with dignity and respect.
- 2 Make sure our policies and procedures promote and respect peoples' rights and freedoms.
- **3** Promote the provision of training and supports for staff and volunteers to meet the provisions of this Charter, including when and how to report a safeguarding concern.
- **4** Make sure we make every reasonable accommodation so that everyone can access and avail of our services.
- **5** Provide support and training to one or more staff members or volunteers to take on the role of Safeguarding Champion in order to promote this Charter and help people to understand how it works across all of our business and services.
